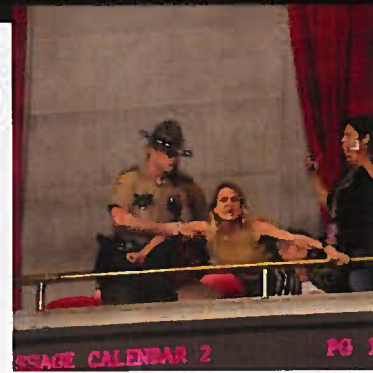

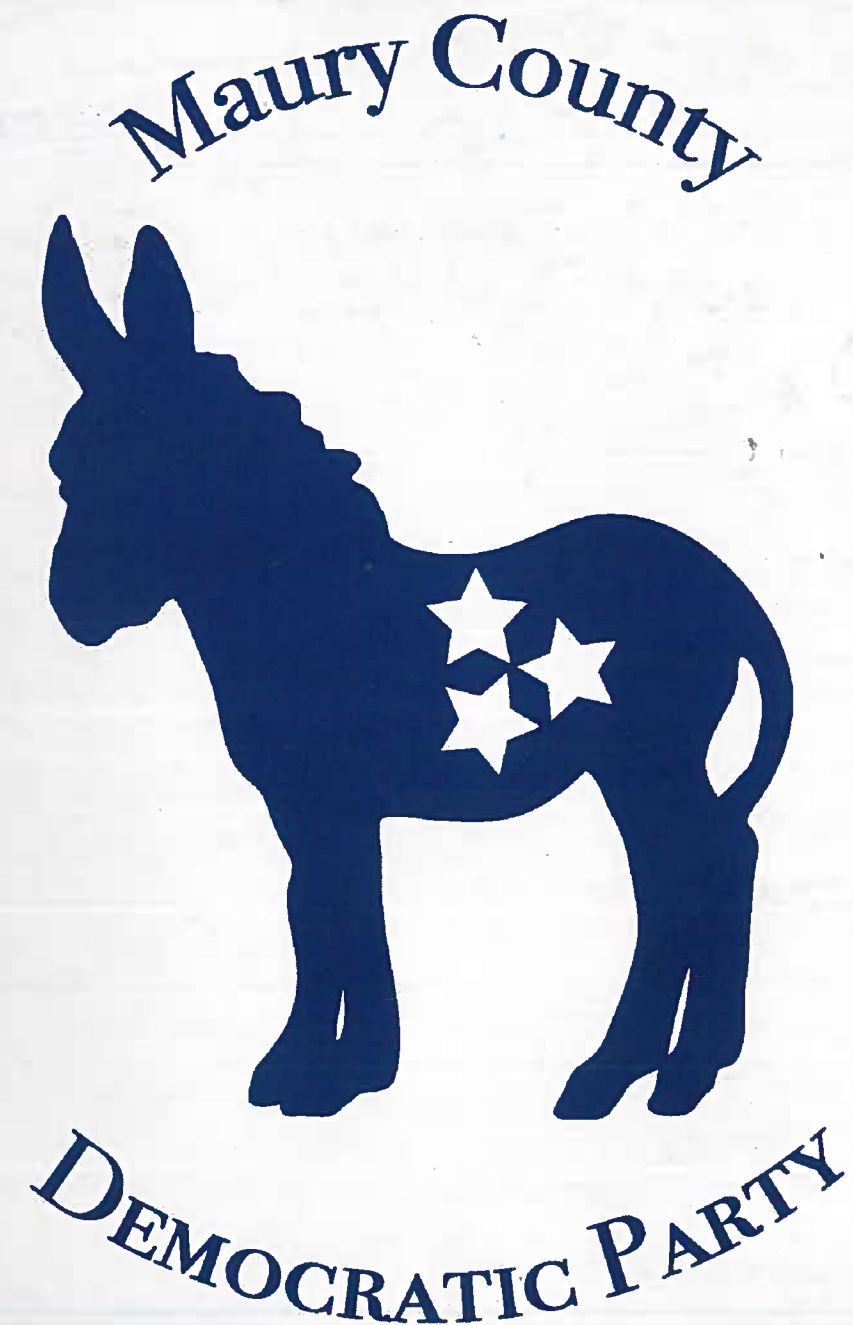

## Jack Cobb Community Service Award

Jack Cobb is a 26-year resident of Columbia, TN, originally hailing from the small town of Carson City, MI. In the early 1970's his family relocated to Lansing where his father worked for General Motors. Jack followed in his father's footsteps and joined General Motors in November 1984. Nine years later, Jack moved his family to Tennessee and joined the Saturn team in Spring Hill. During his 31-year career, Jack took an active role in UAW Local 1853, serving in both leadership and volunteer roles. The union and Saturn both instilled in Jack the importance of giving back to his local community, fighting for workers rights, teaching others and becoming a mentor.

During his tenure at GM as a communications and PR professional, Jack played an integral role in allocating GM Foundation funds to non-profits providing the most critical services to Maury and Williamson counties.

In 2013, Jack joined the Boys & Girls Clubs of Maury County board and served as its chair in 2016. Jack quickly stood out as one of the organizations' most dedicated volunteers and received its first annual new board member of the year award in 2015. Also in 2015 Jack received The Spirit of United Way award for his dedication and service to Maury County. Jack served on the Family Center board from 2014 to 2015, and currently serves on the boards of Harvest Share Food Pantry and Columbia Counseling Ministries. Following Jack's retirement from GM in 2016, he remains active at UAW Local 1853 and works part time as a community liaison at Blood Assurance, this areas' local blood bank. He continues to proudly serve his community by helping those in need find hope for a better tomorrow.



## Jennifer Grisham Life of the Party Award

Jennifer Grisham is an artist (sculpture and pencil drawings) who resides near downtown Columbia, the town she has always called home. She is the "Mom" of two rescued pups, Calhoun and Morgan, and can be seen walking them all over town. She is also Aunt Jenny to three nephews and four great-nieces. Her hobbies include travel, chess, trivia, canasta, and the occasional billiards game.

Jennifer attended Maury County's public schools, Columbia State Community College, and graduated from Vanderbilt University with a degree in psychology. A sculpture studio class at Vanderbilt sparked an interest at creating three-dimensional art which has lasted through the years. She has held positions as a social worker, post office employee, drafter and graphic artist while continuing to make sculpture.

She specialized in portraiture and is currently designing a Christmas Tree ornament for Maury County Democratic Women to be used as a fundraiser. Previously, she created a kicking mule pewter pendant for the MCDW.

Jennifer has been an active volunteer with Big Brothers/Big Sisters fundraisers, Maury County Animal Shelter, Red Cross, teaching CPR and First Aid classes, and Hope house, serving as secretary on their board. She has also donated drawings and sculptures for various auctions and other fundraisers. Jennifer has supported Democratic candidates and the party for years.



## Wanda Ward-Dunn Education and Citizenship

Wanda Ward-Dunn was born and raised in Maury County. She is the daughter of the late Curtis and Beatrice Zachery. 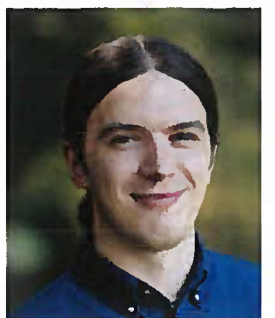


## AJ Holmes Maury County Young Democrat Award

As a first time candidate, AJ worked to carry a common sense message to voters across Maury County in House District 64. A graduate of Columbia Academy, Columbia State Community College, and Middle Tennessee State University, AJ holds a B.S. in Electronic Media Communication/Photography. AJ started his photography business in 2008, and in 2012 was a winner of the NFIB Young Entrepreneurship Foundation Award. The son of Dannie and Tanker Holmes, AJ's family roots in small business run deep in Maury County. His grandmother, Wanda June Seagraves (Mount Pleasant, TN) is one of his biggest inspirations and has always urged him to pursue greatness.
